Also ensuring these courses fulfill the electives required for the AAS.
2. MEC 135 (CET345) will be used to fulfill MET 225 requirement for BSET MET.
3. Take MEC 111, IND 106 and IND 146 or 150 to fulfill STEM 221; and the additional STEM Electives will be used to fulfill ENGN 110 and ENGT 111 requirements for BSET in MET.
