ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST for the Practical Nursing Education Program

- 1. Apply for general admission to Tidewater Community College.
 - List Virginia Beach as your campus of record
 - Request official college/university transcripts be mailed to TCC's Office of the College Registrar
 - Complete and submit the online Request for Evaluation of Previous Educational Experiences form at www.tcc.edu/transfer-credits
- 2. Attend the mandatory PNE Information Session. You must be on time and stay the entire session to meet this requirement.
- 3. All science courses must be completed within 6 years prior to the beginning the first LPN course.
- 4. Take the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam (TEAS) within 2 years prior to application to the PNE program.
- 5. Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) for courses in the nursing program's curriculum of study.
- 6. Submit a complete PNE application packet to the Beazley School of Nursing. A complete application packet includes:
 - the separate Application for Admission to the PNE program.
 - the PNE Application Self-Assessment Form.
 - An official high school/GED transcript (in a sealed envelope) *
 - An official college/university transcript (in a sealed envelope)
 from every college/university you have ever attended, except for
 Tidewater Community College*
 - TEAS test results

*Both the official high school/GED transcript and the second/separate official college/university transcripts should be mailed to you in a sealed envelope to be included in the complete application packet. Do not open these transcripts when received.
