Veteran must provide the following documents: ____ DD Form 214 (Member Copy #4), PHS form 1867, or NOAA Form 56-16 Evidence of Virginia Residence (examples: utility bill, lease, deed, settlement statement, letter from landlord showing current Virginia Address, housing agreement from military housing office). Spouses and Dependents who reside in Virginia (regardless of his or her formal state of residence), who are enrolled at the college and use educational benefits under Chapter 30, 33, or 35 of Title 38, United States Code.
